Request for 60-Day Extension of Time to Amend**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing to you on behalf of my client, Radio Vision Cristiana Management {"Radio Vision"}, licensee of the above-referenced AM station, concerning the possible need for an amendment to our pending application, which Commission staff engineers Son Nguyen and Joseph Szczesny described in an e-mail memo to me dated July 8, 2014. For the reasons that follow, Radio Vision respectfully requests 60 days from today to respond. An original and two (2) copies of this request are being filed.

The July 8 memo states that the proposed nighttime facility of WWRV(AM) will increase the existing 25% RSS limit of co-channel Station WENA(AM), Yauco, Puerto Rico, in violation of Section 73.182 of the Commission's Rules, and identifies the other stations that contribute to the existing WENA(AM) 25% RSS limit.

Radio Vision's technical consultant, Clarence Beverage, and I very much appreciate that information and the suggestion that we should contact Kim Nguyen in the Commission's International Bureau for further guidance. We have done so, and we have also spoken to her supervisor in the International Bureau, Ann Gallagher. We are solidifying our understanding of what stations must be protected, so that we can re-examine our calculations.

Because this proposed change in WWRV's facilities is so important to the station, we may need to request some type of waiver of the Commission's rules or policies to accommodate our situation, instead of filing a pure amendment. Thus, we will need about two weeks to receive further information from the International Bureau and then additional time to consider our position and


