**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC (“Cumulus”), licensee of radio station WFAF, Channel 292A, Mount Kisco, New York. Cumulus also holds an outstanding permit to relocate WFAF to a new site (BPH-20060817ADU). Cumulus herein submits a license application to cover the outstanding permit. A calculation of the transmitter power output of the WFAF transmitter is attached as Exhibit A.

There are two operating conditions/restrictions on the WFAF permit. The first condition states that Cumulus will reduce the power of WFAF or cease operation, as needed, to insure that persons with access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency radiation levels in excess of the Commission’s guidelines. Cumulus will comply with this requirement. The second condition notes that the permit was issued based on the grandfathering provisions of Note 4 to 47 CFR §73.3555 (2003). Cumulus acknowledges this condition. Based on the foregoing, it is believed that WFAF is operating in compliance with the Commission’s rules and that all conditions have been met.
