Dear Mr. Davila:

This letter in reference to the above-captioned application for a major change in commercial FM broadcast station WKXX, Bayamon, P.R.

A preliminary engineering study of the application reveals that the proposed antenna site is short-spaced with reference point for a vacant channel in the FM Table of Assignments. Specifically, the proposed antenna site is located 37 miles (instead of the required minimum of 40 miles) from the reference point for channel 266B, assigned to Ponce, Puerto Rico, in contravention of Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules. You are aware of this short-spacing and, accordingly, have requested a waiver. However, before the waiver request can be acted upon, it will be necessary to submit additional information.

It is necessary to show that there are no suitable non-short spaced sites and if there are no suitable non-short spaced sites, it will be necessary to show that the proposed site is the least short spaced of the suitable short-spaced sites. The lack of availability of alternate sites may be established, for instance, by submitting affidavits from real estate agents. These threshold requirements were adopted by the Commission in Townsend Broadcasting Corporation, 62 FCC 2nd 511, 38 2nd.

Accordingly, further action on the application will be withheld for 30 days from the date of this letter to afford you an opportunity to consider this matter and to submit responsive information, in triplicate, to the Secretary of the Commission in proper amendment form. Failure to respond within 30 days from the date of this letter will result in the return of this application.
