Dear Mr. Liberman:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 12, 2015. TMBL requests a fifth extension of the STA granted on August 15, 2012, due to the collapse of one tower.¹ In support of the request, TMBL states that a method of moments proof is now being prepared.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYOS may continue to operate with a temporary emergency ND antenna and reduced power not to exceed 1.25 kW day and 0.125 kW night. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease

operation if complaints of interference are received. TMBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that TMBL will be able to resume licensed operations by the expiration date shown if a new acceptable FCC Form 302 application is filed in the near future.

This authority expires on **July 5, 2015**.
