Dear Mr. Pugh:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 13, 2017. ERL requests an extension of the STA granted on November 13, 2015, to continue to operate with a long wire antenna pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application to utilize the existing WGRM(AM) transmitter site.¹ In support of the request, ERL stated that it plans to file the application within the next six months to show that substantial progress has been made.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED and ERL may continue to operate with the following facilities:


¹ WKXG(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1540 kHz with 1 kW day and 0.002 kW night.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. ERL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **October 19, 2017**.
