

OTHER AUTHORIZATIONS

Kevin T. Lilly, Brian M. Lilly, and Nicholas B. White each hold an attributable interest in White Broadcasting, LLC and Lilly Broadcasting, LLC. Each of these individuals also holds an attributable interest in SJL Northeast License Subsidiary, LLC, which is the licensee of WBNG-TV, Binghamton, NY; WLYH-TV, Lancaster, PA; WOWK-TV, Huntington, WV and WTAJ-TV, Altoona, PA. Additionally, Kevin T. Lilly and Brian M. Lilly are beneficiaries of a trust that indirectly holds an interest in the licensee entities of stations WICU-TV, Erie, PA and KSBY(TV), San Luis Obispo, CA. Neither Kevin T. Lilly nor Brian M. Lilly are trustees of this trust and neither party exercises any control over the voting of the trust's interests in the indirect parent entities of the licensees of WICU-TV and KSBY(TV). Lastly, Kevin T. Lilly and Brian M. Lilly are brothers and are the sons of George D. Lilly. George D. Lilly holds an attributable interest in television stations WICU-TV, Erie, PA; KSBY(TV), San Luis Obispo, CA; WBNG-TV, Binghamton, NY; WLYH-TV, Lancaster, PA; WOWK-TV, Huntington, WV and WTAJ-TV, Altoona, PA.

Mercury Capital Partners, L.P. holds an attributable interest in White Broadcasting, LLC and Lilly Broadcasting, LLC. Mercury Capital Partners, L.P. also holds a 81.2% voting membership interest in Millennium Radio Group, LLC ("*Millennium Radio*"). Millennium Radio is the ultimate parent company of Millennium Atlantic City License Holdco, LLC ("*Millennium License Holdco*"), the new licensee of WFPG(AM), Atlantic City, New Jersey (FIN: 10448), WFPG-FM, Atlantic City, New Jersey (FIN: 10449), and WPUR(FM), Atlantic City, New Jersey (FIN: 54894).¹

The following subsidiaries of Millennium Radio recently filed applications on FCC Form 314 seeking Commission consent to the voluntarily assignment of the following radio broadcast stations:

- On June 8, 2001, Millennium Central New Jersey License Holdco, LLC filed an application on FCC Form 314 seeking Commission consent to acquire the licenses for radio broadcast stations WKXW(FM), Trenton, New Jersey (FIN: 53458) and WBUD(AM), Trenton, New Jersey (53443) from Press Communications, LLC ("*Press*"). See FCC File Nos. BAL/BAPLH-20010608AAQ, AAR.

¹ On May 11, 2001, the Commission granted the assignment of licenses for the above-referenced stations from Citadel Broadcasting Company ("Citadel") to Millennium License Holdco. See FCC File Nos. BAL/BALH 20010327AGC, AGD, AGE. These assignments were consummated on June 30, 2001. Millennium License Holdco also assumed Citadel's rights and obligations pursuant to a time brokerage agreement for radio station WKOE(FM) in Ocean City, New Jersey (FIN: 49984).

- On June 11, 2001, Millennium Atlantic City II License Holdco, LLC filed an application on FCC Form 314 seeking Commission consent to acquire the licenses for radio broadcast station WBSS-FM, Millville, New Jersey (FIN: 72981) from Press. *See* FCC File No. BALH-20010611AEE.
- On June 18, 2001, Millennium Shore License Holdco, LLC (“*Millennium Shore*”) filed applications on FCC Form 314 seeking Commission consent to acquire radio broadcast stations WJLK-FM, Asbury Park, New Jersey (FIN: 14907), WADB(AM), Asbury Park, New Jersey (FIN: 14895), and WBBO(FM), Ocean Acres, New Jersey (FIN: 59495), from Nassau Broadcasting II, L.L.C. Millennium Shore also simultaneously filed a FCC Form 314 seeking to acquire WOBFM-FM, Toms River, New Jersey (FIN: 59508) from Seashore Broadcasting Corporation, and WOBFM(AM), Lakewood Township, New Jersey, from North Shore Broadcasting Corporation.
