
Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned application for W258AH, Kalamazoo, Michigan.

Our study of the application reveals that the proposed antenna system is mounted above existing directional antenna for WZUU. There is a possibility that the antenna and transmission line will disrupt the directional antenna pattern of WZUU. Accordingly, applicant must submit an exhibit including a statement from each manufacturer of the directional antenna system of WZUU stating that your antenna will have no adverse effect on the directional antenna pattern of WZUU.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to submit the requested information. Failure to respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568.
