

Dear Applicant:

The above-captioned application for a minor modification to a construction permit proposes to change channels from 260L1 to 246L1. The *Second Report & Order* in MM Docket 99-25 established the definition of a "minor change" as it applies to LPFM applications.¹ The Commission stated that minor changes of LPFM stations may include changes of frequencies to adjacent of IF frequencies or, upon a technical showing of reduced interference, to any frequency. Therefore, the instant application specifying a non-adjacent channel change without a technical showing of reduced interference violates Section 73.870(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules.² In addition, the Commission stated that minor change applications would be limited to those specifying changes in site location of 5.6 kilometers or less. Therefore, moving the authorized transmitter site a distance of 7.4 kilometers without the purpose to reduce interference violates the Commission's rule by a distance of 1.8 kilometers.

In light of the above, application BMPL-20141125AZY IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.³
