Dear Mr. Williams:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 1, 2022. CHMG requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 28, 2018, to continue operating with nighttime parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.¹ In support of the request, CHMG states that additional time is needed to resolve all remaining issues before filing the 302 application, which may include the filing of an FCC Form 301 application first to request nighttime augmentation due to a reradiation problem on the 28 degree monitored radial.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CHMG may continue to operate with nighttime parameters at variance and a reduced power level to

maintain all nighttime monitor points within licensed limits, with no change to the licensed daytime operation. CHMG must reduce nighttime power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 11, 2023**.
