Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authorization for Temporary Reduced Power Operation

DTV Station WSRE-DT, Pensacola, FL (Facility ID 17611)

Pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules, the District Board of Trustees of Pensacola Junior College, Florida (the "College") respectfully requests an extension of Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") for the temporary reduced power operation of noncommercial educational DTV Station WSRE-DT, DTV Channel 31, Pensacola, Florida.

The College originally notified the Commission of WSRE-DT's reduced power operation, and requested STA, in FCC File No. BDSTA-20060907AAS. The Commission granted the application on October 31, 2006, and the STA is currently due to expire on April 20, 2007. As the College informed the Commission, the reduced power operation was necessitated by a technical failure involving the station facility, specifically a problem with the air-cooled transmitter's HVAC unit. The equipment problem forced the College to lower the WSRE-DT operating power to 1/3 (33%) of the authorized operating power.

The College has been taking all reasonable steps to repair the WSRE-DT facility and restore full power operation. However, circumstances beyond its control continue to delay the restoration of full power service and necessitate this request for an initial extension of the STA. Notably, delivery of an after-cooler unit is required to allow the College to return WSRE-DT to full power. As previously noted, the College first received approval for the necessary funding, but then was required to wait for those funds to be released before it could follow through on a purchase order. Most recently, equipment delivery delays have hampered the facility repair efforts, and the College does not expect to receive and install the needed unit until May, 2007. As a result, the College hereby requests an additional six-month STA period to provide sufficient time to complete facility repairs and restore full power operation.

The College submits that an STA extension grant will serve the public interest by permitting WSRE-DT to maintain its existing noncommercial educational digital television service for its viewers in the Pensacola area until such time as the equipment is received and can be installed to permit a restored full power operation.

The College is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates WSRE-DT on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, the College qualifies as a governmental entity. This request is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements, pursuant to Section 1.1114 of the Commission's Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules. This request is also exempt from the Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification requirements pursuant to Section 1.2002(c) of the Rules.
