TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Miller Communications, Inc. ("MCI"), licensee of station WIGL, Channel 230A, Saint Matthews, South Carolina. MCI herein proposes to implement a change in the community of license for WIGL from Saint Matthews, South Carolina to Winnsboro, South Carolina with an upgrade to Channel 230C3, using the one-step application procedure as outlined in MB Docket #05-210 (released November 29, 2006).

CITY OF LICENSE CHANGE (EXHIBIT A)

In order to implement this change of community of license and upgrade for WIGL, MCI proposes to relocate the facility to a new site. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration has been apprised of this proposal. When the expected Determination of No Hazard is received, the tower will be registered with the Commission and the Antenna Structure Registration Number provided. At the proposed implementation site, Channel 230C3 does not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to one other station. Therefore, a designated allocation reference site for Channel 230C3 has been identified (Exhibit A). At the implementation site, the shortspace to the other facility is addressed under §73.215 of the Commission's rules (Exhibit B).

As indicated in Exhibit C, the proposed change of community of license from St. Matthews, South Carolina to Winnsboro, South Carolina is mutually exclusive with the current WIGL license; Channel 230C3, from the designated allocation site (different than the proposed implementation site), meets the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements and provides a city grade signal (non-terrain impacted) over all of Winnsboro; and the gain and loss of service areas each receive five full time services from this location. Therefore, this proposal meets the Commission's technical rules for a city of license change.

All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to MCI and is available to the Commission upon request.¹

1) For the purposes of environmental analysis, only the radio frequency radiation evaluation was undertaken by Graham Brock, Inc. The applicant has, or will, review the balance of the environmental reviews (i.e., location of site near areas of historic importance, Indian or tribal areas, etc.).
