DECLARATION

I, Mary Stipe, hereby declare under penalty of perjury:

1. I am the wife of Gene Stipe, President of Little Dixie Radio, Inc.


2. My husband is 78 years old, and currently in poor health.

3. He has suffered from and been treated for prostate cancer.

4. He currently has high blood pressure. The high blood pressure, coupled with stress and depression, created, at least in part, by his legal problems and the current sale of the radio stations, have contributed to the deterioration of his health. He recently has suffered periods of time where he is not able to function in dealing with his business and personal affairs. On Friday, these conditions caused a medical emergency, requiring him to be airlifted by emergency aircraft to St. John's Hospital in Tulsa. He is currently in the hospital, where doctors are working to stabilize his blood pressure and determine what other medical problems contributed to this emergency.

5. The sale of the radio stations has contributed to his current stress and, from what I have been told, to the crisis that lead to his hospitalization this weekend. In recent weeks, he has been very concerned about the delay in the sale of these stations that he has owned, in whole or in part, for over 40 years. I ask the FCC to allow the sale to be completed so as to help relieve the stress on my husband and the health issues that this stress has caused.
