Technical Duopoly Statement
In support of Application for Assignment
For Radio Station

**WXOT (FM), Centre Hall, Pennsylvania
Megahertz Licenses, LLC**

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This technical statement has been prepared on behalf of Megahertz Licenses, LLC (“Applicant”) and is in support of an FCC Form 301, application for Construction Permit to build the facility of the above listed radio station in the State College, PA FCC Geographically Defined Market.

There are currently sixteen (16) stations in the FCC Geographic Market Definition for State College, PA. WXOT (FM) is changing its city of license from Mt. Union, PA to Centre Hall, PA, moving into the FCC Geographic Market of State College, PA. WXOT (FM) upon commencement of programming will become the seventeenth (17th) station in the State College market. The stations in the State College market are listed immediately after this report for your reference.

Pursuant to Section 73.3555 of the Commission’s Rules, the Applicant would be attributed the ownership of four (4) FM stations and two (2) AM stations which is the maximum amount of stations permitted pursuant to the Rule in the State College, PA market. However, a related entity, Forever of PA, LLC, which is attributable to the Applicant, has filed an assignment application to divest Radio Station WLTS (FM), State College, Pennsylvania prior to the filing of the instant application.

The Applicant proposes common ownership of stations in the FCC defined market of State College, PA:

WXOT (FM), Centre Hall, PA
WBUS, (FM), Boalsburg, PA
WJHT (FM), State College, PA
WQWK (FM), State College, PA
WRSC (AM), State College, PA

WMAJ (AM), State College, PA

The total proposed stations for common ownership equals six (6) stations, four (4) FM and two (2) AM stations. Because the State College, PA FCC Geographically Defined Market currently consists of sixteen (16) stations, the Applicant can own up to six (6) stations with four (4) in the same service. Since the Applicant is proposing ownership of four (4) FM and two (2) AM stations, the Applicant is in full compliance with Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules concerning multiple ownership. The stockholders or members of the Applicant do not hold ownership in any other stations in the State College, PA FCC defined market.

Affidavit:

This statement has been prepared by Lynn A. Deppen, a Member of the Applicant, and holder of General Radiotelephone license PG-3-9140. His qualifications are a matter of record with the Commission having been presented and accepted upon many occasions in the past. All statements are true and to the best of my knowledge.
