Good Morning Jerry,

This is to follow up on a prior informal discussion regarding BSTA-20140616AAD for AM Radio Station WUST - New World Radio, Inc. – Facility ID 48686.

In the underlying request for BSTA-20140616AAD, it was proposed to operate WUST temporarily using a non-directional radiator at a replacement site due to the imminent loss of the ability to operate WUST from its presently license site.

The use of one of the host station's (WJFK) original antenna structures, its "West - Tower #2" (FCC ASRN 1292059) was identified as the tower of choice for the temporary operation.

Unfortunately, site implementation logistics and worker activities now dictate that a different tower be used for the non-directional STA operation of WUST. In particular, it is requested that authority be extended to allow the use of the immediately adjoining WJFK "North Tower #4" (FCC ASRN 1292060) for the purposes discussed in the underlying STA request.

No material change in location is caused by this change; the alternative tower is identical to the originally proposed structure in all respects; no change will be created with respect to the previously discussed environmental or RF exposure considerations.
