ADVERSE FINDINGS

On June 29, 2001, in *Karen Esther Williams v. KETV*, Cause No: 8:99CV25, the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska entered final judgment against Station KETV(TV) in a lawsuit alleging violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and the Nebraska Fair Employment Practices Act. The Court ruled in favor of KETV(TV) on all claims except one claim of disparate treatment for leaving work early. KETV(TV) has appealed from this order, and the appeal is pending as of this date.
