Dear Mr. Hoppe:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 23, 2016. RLH requests an extension of the STA granted on November 17, 2014, to operate with temporary facilities due to loss of the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, RLH states additional time will be needed to construct the new two-site facility due to the pending assignment to a new owner, Catholic Radio Network, Inc. (CRN).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is hereby GRANTED, and station KLIM(AM) may continue to operate with the following facilities:



Operating power	0.1 kW
Antenna type	existing tower for KLIM's STL (slant fed)
Antenna efficiency	42.0 mV/m (for 0.1 kW operation)

¹ KLIM(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1220 kHz with 0.25 kW daytime-only, and BP-20151029AUC authorizes a new two-site facility with different daytime and critical hours patterns.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. KLIM(AM) must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 26, 2017**.
