Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application proposing to relocate AM station WDAY and to operate with a directional power of 10 kilowatts both day and night.

Our studies indicate that the proposal will increase the 25 percent RSS night limit of co-channel station WNED, Buffalo, New York. Contributions to WNED's 25 percent night limit are as follows:

The proposed operation would increase WNED's existing 25 percent limit with a contribution of 1.8012 mV/m, in violation of §73.182.

In addition, the proposed 79.4 meter towers require antenna structure registration as they exceed 200 feet and do not meet the criteria for the 6.1 meter rule exception. To date, the ASR database shows no registration numbers for the proposed towers.

Please submit a corrective amendment addressing the deficiencies described above and also provide an update on the status of your filing for concurrence with the state SHPO. Failure to address the deficiencies in the pending application within 30 days from the date of this letter may result in dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute under 47 C.F.R. §73.3568(a)(1). If you have questions, you may contact the processing engineer.
