Dear Edward:

I have taken a look at your proposal to relocate the KDVS transmitter to a new site at the Yolo County Landfill, about 4-1/2 miles northeast of Davis. It is my understanding that you propose to operate with approximately 13 kilowatts effective radiated power and an antenna elevation about 180 feet above ground level.

At its present location on the University of California-Davis campus, third channel adjacent KDVS lies within the KXJZ protected contour. Over the years this has caused interference to our signal in areas on campus near your transmitter.

Having examined the material provided by your consulting engineer, we are convinced that the proposed relocation will move the interference to an unpopulated area. For that reason, we heartily endorse it. We also urge the FCC to grant whatever waivers of the rules that might be necessary so that you may go forward with your project.
