Dear Counsel:

On March 8, 2011, the staff, pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (Communications Act),¹ canceled the license of WPSJ-CA, Hammonton, New Jersey, and deleted its call sign. Engle Broadcasting (Engle) filed a timely petition for reconsideration.² Based on the information set forth therein, the petition for reconsideration IS GRANTED, and the license IS REINSTATED. In light of the actions taken below, however, the station will revert to low power television status.

In addition, on January 13, 2012, Engle and D.T.V. L.L.C., the licensee of WPHA-CD, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, submitted a Joint Request for Approval of Settlement Agreement to resolve



certain conflicts between themselves, including the dismissal of all pending petitions to deny and related pleadings. Specifically, they request that the Commission approve their Settlement Agreement and grant the above-captioned applications.³

Upon review of the Settlement Agreement and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act and Section 73.3588 of the Commission's rules. Furthermore, we find that the applicants are fully qualified and conclude that the grant of the applications would serve the public interest.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the Settlement Agreement, dated January 12, 2012, between Engle Broadcasting and D.T.V. L.L.C. is GRANTED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the application of D.T.V. L.L.C. for displacement of WPHA-CD, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to Channel 24, File No. BDISTA-20110315ABL, is GRANTED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the application of Engle Broadcasting to convert WPSJ-LD, as authorized in its Channel 38 construction permit, to Class A status, File No. BLDTA-20110901AAT, is GRANTED.
