Cross Ownership Showing
In Support of an Amendment to an Application to
Change Daytime and Nighttime Power
WOKR – Brighton, NY

The application, filed on behalf of Genesee Media Corporation (“Applicant”), proposes a minor change in the licensed facility of station WOKR(AM), Brockport, NY (Fac. ID 88676) (the “Station”). The Station is “home” to, and its community of license is within, the Rochester, NY Arbitron metropolitan area (“Rochester Metro”). Grant of the application will result in Applicant, and entities with an attributable interest in Applicant (collectively, the “Applicant Parties”), having an attributable interest in more than one radio station in the Rochester Metro. This exhibit demonstrates that the proposed minor change in the licensed facility of the Station is consistent with the Commission’s local radio ownership rule in Section 73.3555(a).

LOCAL RADIO OWNERSHIP LIMITS

One or more of the Applicant Parties holds a direct or indirect attributable interest in the radio stations listed in Table 1, attached hereto. No Applicant Party holds an attributable interest in any radio station other than those included in Table 1. The following four stations listed in Table 1 are “home” to the Rochester Metro:

According to the BIA database, there are 31 commercial and noncommercial educational full-power radio stations licensed in the Rochester Metro. Per local radio ownership limits set forth in Section 73.3555(a), a person or single entity (or entities under common control) may have a cognizable interest in licenses for AM or FM radio broadcast stations in a radio market with between 30 and 44 (inclusive) full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations of not more than 7 commercial radio stations in total and not more than 4 commercial stations in the same service (AM or FM).

Grant of this application will result in the Applicant Parties' having a cognizable interest in exactly one FM and three AM full-power commercial radio stations in the Rochester Metro. Thus, the proposed minor change in the licensed facility of the Station complies with the local radio ownership limits set forth in Section 73.3555(a).

Based on the foregoing, Applicant hereby certifies that the minor modification to the licensed facility of the Station proposed herein fully complies with the local radio ownership restrictions set forth in Section 73.3555(a) of the Commission's rules.
