New Northwest Broadcasters LLC (“NNB”), licensee of radio station KRPM(FM), Billings, Montana (the “Station”), pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission’s Rules (47 C.F.R. §§ 73.1560(d), 73.1635), respectfully requests extension of special temporary authority (“STA”) for NNB to operate the Station at variance from its licensed parameters. Despite its diligent efforts, NNB has been unable to restore full power operations due to circumstances beyond its control.

On June 4, 2007, the FCC granted STA for NNB to operate the Station at reduced power during repair or replacement of the Station’s antenna, which had experienced a major failure on April 27, 2007. (BSTA-20070529AAB). At the time that NNB initially filed for STA, it had placed an order with the original antenna manufacturer for a replacement antenna and believed that it would receive and be able to install that antenna within four to six weeks. Subsequent to grant of that STA request, however, NNB determined that the original manufacturer would not be able to supply it with a reasonably acceptable replacement antenna. As a result, NNB has been forced to order a replacement antenna from a different manufacturer. NNB anticipates receiving that antenna within the next three to four weeks. Upon delivery, NNB plans to promptly install the new equipment, return the station to its full operating power, and make the appropriate submissions to the FCC.

In view of the foregoing, NNB respectfully requests an extension of STA to operate KRPM(FM) with parameters at variance from its licensed parameters.
