This letter concerns a Notice of Apparent Liability (“NAL”) issued on August 5, 2008, to MSG Radio, Inc. (“MSG”), for its willful violation of Section 1.80(b)(4) of the Commission’s Rules (“Rules”)¹ by failing to provide required information on the above-captioned application for the assignment of license of Station WTOK-FM (formerly WIAC-FM), San Juan, Puerto Rico, from Luis A. Mejia to MSG. An Application for Review of that *NAL* was filed on September 22, 2011, and remains pending.

The Notice of Apparent Liability is hereby CANCELLED. MSG is instead hereby ADMONISHED for its violation of Section 1.80 of the Rules.
