Emery County has filed an application for a Station authorization for a new BSFDTT-20060630ARH Channel 40 to serve Orangeville, Utah.

Emery County is also aware that Carbon County, Utah has also filed an application for a Station authorization on channel 40 with a file number BSFDTT-20060630BMP, which shows predicted interference with the BSFDTT-20060630ARH channel 40 serving Orangeville, Utah.

Because of several issues, including Mountain terrain shielding, Emery County does not expect the proposed Carbon County application BSFDTT-20060630BMP CH 40 to interfere with the new BSFDTT-20060630ARH channel 40 serving Orangeville, Utah.

We therefore, have no objection, to the granting of the application from Carbon County, Utah for a construction permit on file number BSFDTT-20060630BMP CH 40. No monetary or other compensations have been exchanged for this agreement. If Interference becomes a problem in the future we will work with Carbon County to eliminate it.
