The licensee has been struggling to remove the existing tower and to construct a new tower. The existing tower cannot be climbed due its advanced deterioration. Consequently, two cranes are required to dismantle the existing tower. The logistics involved in engaging two crane companies to dismantle the tower have proved difficult due to Covid and the weather. Recent tornadoes and extreme winter weather have the crane companies fully engaged but they have informed the licensee that they will work on this project during the first quarter of 2022. No definite date has been set by the crane or tower construction companies. The licensee continues to serve its community at lower power and is anxious to resume operation at full power. Accordingly, due to circumstances beyond its control, the licensee requests that its existing engineering STA be extended.
