

**Explanation of Transaction**

The instant application is one of a group of concurrently filed applications seeking Commission consent to the assignment of the licenses of five full power commercial television stations, two Class A commercial television stations, and related auxiliary and other facilities from entities associated with Four Points Media Group, LLC, ("Four Points"), which is in turn ultimately controlled by Cerberus Capital Management, LP, to four entities ultimately controlled by Sinclair Broadcast Group, Inc. ("Sinclair").

Sinclair does not currently have an attributable interest in any television station or other media entity located within any of the Nielsen Designated Market Areas ("DMAs") of the communities of license of any of the Four Points stations being acquired. While Sinclair proposes to acquire two Four Points television stations which are licensed to communities in the Salt Lake City, Utah, DMA, the stations are located in Salt Lake City and St. George, in the northeastern and far southwestern portions of Utah, respectively, and there is no overlap of the relevant contours of the two stations. Therefore, the proposed transaction is fully compliant with the provisions of Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules.
