**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits are prepared on behalf of Atlantic Radio Broadcasting, LLC (“ARB”), licensee of FM radio station WRXS, Channel 295A, Ocean City, Maryland. ARB herein proposes to make minor changes in the facilities of WRXS by relocating the station, increasing the center of radiation and height above average terrain, decreasing the effective radiated power and utilizing a directional antenna.

ARB proposes to install the proposed directional antenna system for WRXS on a new tower. Therefore, the Federal Aviation Administration has been apprised of this proposal and a Determination of No Hazard has been issued. The tower has been registered with the Commission and assigned Antenna Structure Registration number 1227587.

From the proposed WRXS site, Channel 295A does not meet the minimum distance separation requirements to several other facilities. Attached as Exhibit A is a §73.215 review for WRXS, based on the actual site proposed, demonstrating there is no prohibited overlap of contours between WRXS and the other facilities.
