Dear Deb,

I received your letter several weeks ago indicating the need for KFAI to move its transmitter and antenna from the Foshay Tower by February 28, 2007. I am writing today to request an extension of time.

Since our last conversation, I have been working with technical engineers and other personnel to locate a suitable site for moving our transmitter and antenna. Several potential locations were not available to KFAI or did not respond to our inquiries. It appears we have found a site, however we are still in negotiation with the site because we will be required to change several aspects of our transmitter equipment and antenna in conjunction with the move from the Foshay Tower.


Also noted in our conversations, KFAI will have to seek permission from the Federal Communications Commission to move from the Foshay Tower to another location. The time frame for seeking "special temporary authority" to move KFAI's equipment is at least 90 days. If KFAI's move results in possible interference with another frequency, the approval process may take longer.

In your letter dated November 14, 2006, you indicated that you may have more information in the next month (December) with regards to power consistently being available in the building during the redevelopment. At this juncture, such an option would be extremely important and beneficial to KFAI, eliminating the real possibility of taking the station off the air if approval is not granted by the FCC by February 28, 2007.

On behalf of KFAI's board of directors and listeners, I am requesting an extension of time in which to move. Any consideration of additional time would be gratefully appreciated.

Thank you, in advance, for your consideration and understanding.
