Dear Mr. Price:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 11, 2017. TMDL requests an extension of the STA granted on April 1, 2016, to operate with parameters at variance due to required work/repairs.¹ In support of its request TMDL states that additional time is needed to complete all repairs in order to resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


¹ WINE(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 940 kHz with 0.68 kW day and 0.004 kW night.

If measurements show the resistance differs from the last license by more than 2%, then an FCC Form 302 direct measurement of power application should be filed, which should include a text description of the skirt-fed antenna system and ground system. Otherwise, TMDL must submit an e-mail to the Audio Division staff to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations with negligible changes before the expiration date shown below.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TMDL may continue to operate with parameters at variance. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMDL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **August 1, 2017**.
