

NATURE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES OF APPLICANT

Non-Profit and Educational Nature

It is the intent of the applicant to operate the proposed station in a manner consistent with Subpart G of Part 73 of the Commission's Rules.

The applicant, a non-profit educational organization, is a North Dakota non-profit corporation which was incorporated April 26, 2012. The purposes for which the Corporation was formed are charitable, religious and educational in nature. Its registered office and headquarters is located at 1531 6th Avenue, NE, Jamestown, North Dakota, at approximate NAD27 coordinates 46° 55' 25" north latitude and 98° 42' 1" west longitude. Our antenna location is NAD27 coordinates 46° 55' 25.2" north latitude and 98° 45' 54.2" west longitude, which is 3.057 miles west of our headquarters.

As we understand Section 73.853 of the FCC's Rules and Regulations, the applicant qualifies as a local non-profit educational organization as its headquarters is located within 20 miles of the proposed antenna site. Additionally, all of the directors of the applicant have lived within 20 miles of the proposed antenna location for at least the last 24 months.

As a non-profit corporation with specific educational, religious and charitable purposes, the applicant is an "educational organization" eligible to be licensed in the low power FM service. Further, In *Columbia Bible College Broadcasting Co.*, 6 FCC Rcd 516 (1991), at paragraphs 9 and 10, the Commission stated that religiously-oriented

applicants can meet the eligibility standards set forth in Section 73.503 of the Commission's Rules, where the applicant (1) proposes an overall educational program and (2) its proposed programming furthers its educational objectives. As can be seen by this Exhibit, the applicant is a local non-profit educational organization, its purposes evidence an overall educational program, and our programming will further its educational objectives.

Furtherance of Educational Objectives

The applicant is eligible pursuant to Section 73.503 to be a non-commercial licensee of the station covered by this application, because the applicant proposes programming which constitutes an overall educational program and the programming furthers the organization's educational objectives. In this case, the applicant intends to broadcast programs to further its educational purposes

Although the exact titles and subject matter of the programs will be determined at the time the proposed station is constructed and ready for operation, we can state that the selection of all programs to air on our proposed station will be consistent with and guided by the foregoing mission statement.

The proposed low power FM station will also work with local Roman Catholic parishes, catechism programs and organizations to assist their educational efforts with respect to teaching of the Catholic religion.

In sum, it is our objective to use the proposed radio station to provide a valuable educational resource for the residents of the area that we propose to serve.
