TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits are prepared on behalf of Miller Communications, Inc. ("Miller"), licensee of FM Radio Station WICI-FM, Channel 234A (94.7 MHz), Sumter, South Carolina. Miller herein proposes to make minor changes in the facilities of WICI-FM by relocating the transmitter site, increasing the height above average terrain (HAAT) and effective radiated power (ERP), and changing class from Class A to Class C3.

The potential for a Class C3 upgrade is based on protecting WAAW, Channel 234A, Williston, South Carolina, at their new tower site. This instant application references the WAAW application site at North Latitude 33° 30' 31" and West Longitude 81° 37' 27".¹ The clearance for the Class C3 upgrade allotment at Sumter is based upon those coordinates for WAAW. From the proposed allocation and application site, the required 70 dBu (3.16 mV/m) city grade service contour is delivered to Sumter, South Carolina.
