

Displacement

The WCHU-LP application was granted because it did not predict to cause any interference to any other facility as analyzed by the Commission's tv_process_lptv software. However, it does predict to cause interference to W52BR, which is now operating on channel 46 since early June 2006 (FCC File No. BLTTTL-20060607AAR, Facility ID 61692), when analyzed by the Commission's newer tv_process_dlptv software. As analyzed by the Commission's tv_process_dlptv software, the operating facility of WCHU-LP causes new interference to between 6.7% and 10.0% of the population within the service area of W52BR as operating on channel 46. In order to not interfere with the authorized facility of W52BR, WCHU-LP must cease operations on channel 61. Thus, it is displaced.
