On January 16, 2002 measurements were taken of the WQHT, WRKS and WQCD auxiliary transmitters in West Orange, NJ using a Tektronix model 2712 spectrum analyzer.

All three transmitters were run at their nominal power levels and no spurious emissions were found on a frequency removed from the unmodulated carriers by more than 120 kHz.
