Request to Reclassify Station WROQ(FM), Anderson, South Carolina

Station WROQ(FM), Anderson, South Carolina, licensed to OBC Broadcasting, Inc., operates at 301 meters (987 feet) height above average terrain. On January 19, 2001, the Commission's Second Report and Order in MM Docket No. 98-93, FCC 00-368, released November 1, 2000, became effective. This action amended Section 73.3573 by adding Note 4. This Note implements the new height requirement for a Class C station. A station must operate from a height of at least 450 meters to retain its Class C status. The procedure to reclassify a station must be triggered by a demand for the spectrum not being used by the Class C station.

Susquehanna Radio Corp. ("Susquehanna"), licensee of Station WABZ-FM, Indian Trail, North Carolina, in accordance with Note 4, formally requests that the Commission reclassify Station WROQ(FM) as a Class C0. Susquehanna herein certifies that no alternative channel is available for the service it proposes in this application for minor change in licensed facilities. A copy of this minor change application is being served on OBC Broadcasting, Inc.
