TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Vandalia Media Partners, LLC (“Vandalia”), licensee of FM translator station W294AF, Channel 294, Ripley, West Virginia. Vandalia holds a construction permit (BPFT-20170410AEH) to increase the height of the W294AF antenna. This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding construction permit. Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for W294AF.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W294AF permit.

The first condition states:

“The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.”

Vandalia pledges compliance with this condition.

The second condition states:

“Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.”

This application satisfies that condition.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that Vandalia has complied with all conditions and can operate W294AF in accordance with Commission’s rules.
