As you know from previous correspondence, QUALCOMM Incorporated (QUALCOMM) purchased licenses from the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to operate a wireless system in TV Channel 55 (716-722 MHz) on a nationwide basis. QUALCOMM is considered a primary service relative to secondary services operating in the band. In accordance with our licenses and Part 27 of the FCC's rules, QUALCOMM has installed and is operating transmitters in the referenced area during Calendar Year 2006 and 2007.

QUALCOMM understands that you are the licensee of the subject LD in channel 55. Under the FCC's rules (Part 74.703 (e)), low power TV and TV translator stations are authorized on a secondary basis to existing land mobile uses and must correct whatever interference they cause to land mobile stations or cease operation. The FCC has stated that LPTVs (including relays and translator relays) are authorized on a non-interfering basis to primary services, including "...other new wireless services that are operating or will operate in the spectrum comprising TV Channels 52-69".

QUALCOMM is providing notice that the subject LD/CP, as currently licensed and operating or proposing to operate on channel 55, is predicted to cause interference to QUALCOMM's Channel 55 transmitters and respectfully requests that the subject licensed LPTV cease operations or cease plans to operate in Channel 55.
