Request for Authority to Continue Operations with Emergency Antenna

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Quantum of Brunswick License Company, LLC ("Quantum"), I am hereby respectfully requesting that Quantum be authorized to continue operation of WYNR(FM) with emergency facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680 of the Commission's rules.

WYNR(FM) shares facilities with WQGA(FM), Waycross, Georgia. The tower on which WYNR(FM) and WQGA(FM) are located was struck by lightning several months ago. A problem with the transmission line that apparently stems from that lightning strike is now preventing either station from operating at full licensed power. Arrangements have been made to replace that transmission line. It is expected that work to replace the transmission line should begin in approximately two weeks and will take approximately two weeks to complete. In the interim, Quantum wishes to continue providing service over WYNR(FM). So as to permit WYNR(FM) to remain on the air while the transmission line is being replaced, Quantum is making use of a single-bay antenna mounted at approximately the 350 foot level of the tower used by Quantum's WHFX(FM) and WGIG(AM). That tower is located at 31°, 10', 9" NL; 81°, 32', 14" WL (ASR No. 1020860). The antenna is being fed by a transmitter operating at approximately 1 kW. WYNR(FM) normally operates at an ERP of 97 kW.

As noted above, it is expected that, weather permitting, the damaged transmission line at WYNR(FM)'s licensed location will be replaced in approximately four weeks. Allowing Qantum to continue operating WYNR(FM) with the temporary facilities set forth above would be in the public interest inasmuch as it would permit Qantum to continue to provide service to the public while the damaged transmission line is being replaced.

The requisite anti-drug certification and filing fee of \$175.00 are enclosed herewith.


