Dear Mr. Black,

This letter is in response to your request for an interference waiver from Raycom Media and KSLA-DT, Shreveport, LA. We are in receipt of your letter of July 26, 2000 and have analyzed the interference potential between K17EQ and KSLA-DT.

We are licensed and intend to construct full power DTV facilities. While the probability of interference exists due to physical spacing, Longley-Rice models indicate that probability to be somewhat remote.

Therefore, Raycom Media and KSLA-DT grant a waiver conditional on measured interference. If at any time, after KSLA-DT commences operation, objectionable interference is encountered, it will be required that K17EQ immediately reduce power until the interference is eliminated and a permanent remedy put in place.
