Dear Barbara:

This Letter, filed in triplicate, formally notifies the FCC, on behalf of the Licensee of KRDO-TV, that on April 12, 2012, at approximately 4:30AM (MDT), an admitted technical error by Comcast apparently caused pornographic visual material to be cablecast for a brief period of time on the Comcast cable system serving the Colorado Springs DMA -- on a cable channel that normally carries KRDO-TV's programming. Comcast has notified the Licensee in writing that it takes full responsibility for this error, that it is taking steps to ensure that no repeat of this incident will occur, and that it will further advise KRDO-TV when and how that problem is fully resolved.

Although KRDO-TV is in no way responsible for this occurrence and has advised its viewers of that fact and also that KRDO-TV sincerely regrets this error by Comcast, the Licensee has received numerous complaints from local viewers and, thus, has concluded that the FCC should be made aware of this unusual incident and the relevant circumstances, in the eventuality that the matter comes to the attention of the Video Division or the FCC's Enforcement Branch, which is being served by E-Mail.

Accordingly, this matter is being formally reported, with a request that this Letter be added to the KRDO-TV license file at the FCC.
