Re-submission of DTV “Phased Transition” STA Application

NCE Station KDIN-TV/DT, Des Moines, IA Facility ID: 29102

Iowa Public Broadcasting Board (“IPTV”), supplements and amends a pending application in FCC File No. BLDSTA-20080730AKO for “Phased Transition” Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) for noncommercial educational Station KDIN-TV/DT, Des Moines, Iowa. This STA application proposes to maintain temporary use of the station’s in-core pre-transition DTV channel beyond the February 17, 2009 transition date.

IPTV electronically filed its Phased Transition STA application for KDIN on July 30, 2008 (copy attached), seeking authorization to continue operation of KDIN-DT on pre-transition DTV Channel 50 until August 18, 2009, while IPTV works towards completing the build-out of its authorized post-transition DTV facility on Channel 11 (the station’s current analog channel). However, Media Bureau staff subsequently informed IPTV that the proposed temporarily extended operation of KDIN-DT on Channel 50 raised an interference concern with respect to KGAN, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, post-transition DTV Channel 51. Accordingly, on December 2, 2008, IPTV submitted a paper amendment to the Legal STA application to propose continued operation of KDIN-DT’s licensed pre-transition DTV Channel 50 facility **at a reduced power of 404 kW ERP**.¹ FCC staff subsequently requested that the filing be re-submitted through CDBS as an online Engineering STA. Thus this electronic filing should serve to replace the paper filing submitted on December 2, 2008 to amend the initial STA request in File No. BLDSTA-20080730AKO.

Please see attached engineering statement, which demonstrates that the continued operation of KDIN-DT’s DTV Channel 50 facility at the lower power level will not cause impermissible interference to any other station, and will result in no loss of current analog service, and a *de minimis* loss of existing DTV coverage, until the authorized KDIN-DT post-transition facility is completed.

We respectfully request that the Media Bureau continue to process KDIN’s Phased Transition STA request, as amended by this application. For all of the reasons set forth in the station’s initial STA application (copy attached), IPTV submits that the grant will facilitate the KDIN DTV transition and serve the public interest.

IPTV is a noncommercial educational broadcaster and a governmental entity, and is exempt from FCC filing fees under Section 1.1114 of the FCC’s Rules and from FCC regulatory fees under Section 1.1162 of the FCC’s Rules.

¹ KDIN-DT’s current pre-transition DTV Channel 50 license specifies an ERP of 966 kW ERP.
