- 2 This is to notify you that the grant of this construction permit is subject to the condition that this facility can not commence operation prior to midnight of February 17, 2009, or by such other date as the Commission may establish in the future, without prior approval from the Commission.
- 3 Operation with the facilities specified herein is subject to the following condition: If a television station listed below is authorized by Canada and begins operation, it must be protected. Protection must be determined to be acceptable by both the FCC and the Canadian government, and may be based on additional negotiation regarding the current facilities, an agreement to accept interference or the operation of reduced facilities. Unless it is deleted earlier, this condition expires at the end of the Canadian DTV transition, currently expected to be August, 2011.
