Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. Installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein shall be in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules.

- During installation of the antenna authorized herein, AM Station(s) listed below shall determine operating power by the indirect method. Upon completion of the installation, antenna impedance measurements on the AM antenna shall be made and, prior to or simultaneous with the filing of the application for license to cover this permit, the results submitted to the Commission (along with a tower sketch of the installation) in an application for the AM station to return to the direct method of power determination. (Revised January 28, 1983) WSBC
- The authorization of a license to operate this station is conditioned upon the use of a transmitter that has been type accepted or meets Commission type acceptance requirements at a visual carrier frequency tolerance of plus/minus 1 kHz. In the event the transmitter has not been type accepted at this tolerance, the permittee shall, in the license application, provide full engineering data that demonstrates compliance with Section 74.750 (c)(3)(iii) of the Commission's Rules.
- THIS CONSTRUCTION PERMIT IS CONDITIONED THAT ITS 20 WATTS TRANSMITTER OUTPUT POWER IS DIVIDED INTO 14.92 WATTS HORIZONTAL OUTPUT POWER WHICH WILL FEED 3.36 WATTS TO EACH HORIZONTALLY POLARIZED ANTENNA ARRAY, AND 4.84 WATTS VERTICAL OUTPUT POWER.
