- 1 The relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component shall exceed at any azimuth the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by construction permit BNPED-20071018ADV.

A relative field strength of 1.0 on the composite radiation pattern herein authorized corresponds to the following effective radiated power:

0.200 kilowatt.

Principal minima and their associated field strength limits:

70 degrees True through 210 degrees True: 0.0063 kilowatt.

- 2 Community Radio of Northern Colorado requests waiver of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 to operate the proposed facility as "satellite" of co-owned noncommercial educational FM station KUNC (FM), Greeley, Colorado, Facility ID No. 68219. Based upon the specific representations contained therein, the waiver request IS GRANTED. Applicant shall abide by each representation proffered in the waiver request.
- 3 The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
