The other young hosts, whose ages range from pre-teen to late teens, are equally entertaining and informative. The young viewers identify with these young hosts and imagine themselve the role of the scientist and as someone who could have a positive impact on the environment. The form of young student scientists presenting information on location in a variety of aquatic settings is both entertaining and informative.
