The station notified listing guides about these additional core episodes, and the station aired an informational crawl to promote the Special Edition episodes. On June 12, 2016, NBC Network aired breaking news coverage of the tragedy in Orlando. The coverage resulted in the preemption of the following Children's programs: Teen Kids News 12:00-12:30PM and 12:30-1:00PM.
