The shop's one employee, Kelly doubles as Chica's nanny and the esemble is rounded out with Bunji, a large floppy eared rabbit and stitches, a star mannequin that sits in the window. In each episode Chica develops or encounters a problem that she cannot immediately resolve. Usually her issues involve impulse control, distractibility, judgment and interpersonal behaviors. She and Kelly usually work in the problem through an adventure a fantasy transformation to animation where Bunji and Stitches come alive and join Chica and Kelly for the problem solving process.
