The technical issue has now been resolved, and all regularly scheduled Bounce TV E/I programming has included the E/I symbol as of October 22, 2016 except for one episode on November 5, 2016. Bounce TV also has established new processes to ensure that the issue does not recur. To address any possible concerns about compliance with FCC requirements for E/I programming, Bounce TV will re-broadcast the 12.5 hours of E/I programming that originally aired without an E/I symbol in addition to regularly scheduled E/I programming.
