WGEN-TV airs numerous public service announcements discussing topics directly relevant to children and families. WGEN-TV was off the air from September 6 until November 14, 2017, as a result of Hurricane Irma. Nonetheless, WGEN-TV's primary channel children's programming was made available to viewers in the market because WGEN-TV has continued to provide its programming to the major MVPDs in the market via a fiber feed. However, WGEN-TV's multicast Channel is not distributed via MVPD, which means its children's programming did not air between September 6 and November 14, 2017. Finally, the station became an independent station as of November 1, 2017.
