The :15 themes of these PSA's deal with the environment, tolerance, mentoring, and violence prevention. The More You Know's website (<a href="http://www.nbc.com/tmyk">www.nbc.com/tmyk</a>) features scripts from the award-winning public service announcements, referral information for the organizations referenced in the PSAs, a general campaign overview, and educational materials produced in connection with NBC programming. The site also includes "a list of the campaign's most recent accolades.
