In each episode Chica develops or encounters a problem that she cannot immediately resolve. Usually her issues involve impulse control, distractibility, judgment , and inter personal behaviors. She and Kelly usually work on the problem through adventure - a fantasy transformation to animation where Bunji and Stitches come alive and join Chica and Kelly for the problem solving process. Each truck brings specific skills to the group. They get challenging job assignments from Mr. Bill Board, a digital outdoor screen that outlines and diagrams the problem to be solved. During third quarter 2016, WLWT aired 8 additional episodes of the regularly scheduled core children's program "Teen Kids News." In each instance that a "Special Edition" of Teen Kids News aired, it was aired back-to-back with another episode of Teen Kids News, which created a series of "mini-marathons" of the program at points throughout the quarter. These additional airings of the program were intended to help increase audience awareness of the program and to further educate and inform teen children viewers about topical, current news events, during a significant election year. These additional core episodes were promoted as special editions and viewers were made aware of the times via crawls and program services. This station, like many other NBC Television Network affiliates, experienced difficulty during Third Quarter in airing and rescheduling its children's E/I programs, largely as a result of the Olympics which were aired live on our station. The NBC Television Network notified the FCC by letter that stations may need additional regulatory flexibility during the quarter to meet their children's E/I obligations.
