See 47 C.F.R. Section 73.671, NOTES 2 and 3.	Due to a technical error, 10.5 hours of LAFF Network programming that aired between 9/10/16 and 10/15/16 did not contain the E/I symbol. The technical issue has since been resolved, and all regularly scheduled LAFF E/I programming has included the E/I symbol as of October 22, 2016. LAFF also has established new processes to ensure that this issue does not recur. To address any possible concerns about compliance with FCC requirements for E/I programming, LAFF re-broadcast the 10.5 hours of E/I programming that originally aired without the E/I symbol, plus one additional half-hour of E/I programming, for a total of 11 hours of E/I programming in addition to LAFF's regularly scheduled E/I programming. See attached LAFF make up broadcasts attachment. The FCC Staff was notified of the error and the steps taken to resolve the error.
